

California Cruising – San Juan Islands

The San Juan Islands, some 60 miles north of Seattle, are a democratic archipelago: there is something for everyone! This cruise takes you through and around the San Juan Islands. Beginning in Anacortes head west through the islands cruising south west direction passing through customs into Canadas territories. Head to the east side of Salspring Island then up to Galiano Island. Back into the states to the tip of San Juan Island and head east to Sucia Island, WA. Crusie north to Blaine, WA for your final stop before heading back to Anacortes to Cap Sante Marina.

HIGHLIGHTS

Located between Seattle and Vancouver, B.C. on beautiful Fidalgo Island, Anacortes is known as the gateway to the San Juan Islands. The city maintains a park on the northwestern end of Fidalgo Island named "Washington Park". This park features camping, boat launching, and majestic views of the San Juan Islands. The most prominent view is of Cypress Island.

HIGHLIGHTS

Friday Harbor is the social and political center of the region, with a small-town feel and quaint shops. September and October are great times to go without the high-season competition for slips, anchorages and dinner reservations. The San Juan Island Farmers' Market (www.sjifarmersmarket.com), which in August is slated to move into the Brickworks, a renovated historic commercial building. Some of the world's best porpoise, seal, bald eagle, and Orca whale watching is found just off the coast of San Juan Island.

HIGHLIGHTS

Pass through customs at Port Sidney. Conveniently located a short walk from the charming seaside town of Sidney, British Columbia, Canada where you will find great specialty shops, fine bakeries, nine wonderful book stores, a diversity of fine restaurants, unique cafes, a movie theatre, art galleries plus a full compliment of all services. Sidney is located on the southern tip of Vancouver Island on the Saanich Peninsula. Sidney's main attraction is its position on the Salish Sea. Sidney-by-the-Sea is the gateway to the southern Gulf Islands National Park Reserve, and is a popular eco-tourist destination, with whale-watching, bird-watching, kayaking and scubadiving.

HIGHLIGHTS

Ideally situated in the heart of the Southern Gulf Islands between Vancouver and Vancouver Island. Hike one of the many trails, explore the beautiful Montague Marine Park, which is a short walk from the Marina, or take a trip to Sturdies Bay Village and meet the locals. If you are looking for a bit more solitude, and the wind is not coming from the North or Northwest, you can also anchor out near the beach on the North side of the spit.

HIGHLIGHTS

Back to the US to clear customs at Roche Harbor. Roche Harbor is a sheltered harbor on the northwest side of San Juan Island. Roche Harbor sits along Haro Strait and Canada – United States border. The harbor itself provides one of the better protected anchorages in the islands.

7. - Estimated Mileage: 15

Sucia Island – Fossil Bay

HIGHLIGHTS

Fossil Bay on Sucia Island shows the Ice Age evolution of this island chain, with fossils embedded in rocks worn smooth by glaciers.
